ROUND 1

Content Scoring based on uploaded material alone Each set of material uploaded will be judged on the following criteria:

TEXT AND GRAPHICS ARE BALANCED AND USED EFFECTIVELY <ul style="list-style-type: none">graphics serve a purposetext is concise and clear	10%
ORGANIZATIONAL FLOW <ul style="list-style-type: none">information is provided in a logical manner	20%
CONTEXT AND MOTIVATION <ul style="list-style-type: none">the larger context of the work is clearthe research objective is identified	20%
CONTRIBUTION AND SIGNIFICANCE <ul style="list-style-type: none">the presenter's contribution is presented in an understandable waythe work undertakes a challenging goal, involves considerable effort, and leads to new insight relevant to the research objectivethe importance and novelty of the results are clearly identified	40%

ROUND 2

Posters who succeed in round 1 of the competition will be eligible for an interview (5 minutes maximum). Each poster presenter will be asked the following three questions. Criteria by which answers are judged are given in bullet point form below the question.

"CAN YOU EXPLAIN THE CONTEXT AND THE SPECIFIC GOAL OF THE WORK YOU ARE DOING?" <ul style="list-style-type: none">The presenter shows mastery of the larger research fieldThe goal of the research is clear and makes sense in this context	30%
"PLEASE EXPLAIN YOUR CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE RESEARCH." <ul style="list-style-type: none">Explanations are at a level understandable by a non-specialistThe presenter's contributions involve substantial work and advance the goal of the research projectThe presenter demonstrates detailed knowledge of the techniques used	50%
"WHAT IS THE SIGNIFICANCE OF YOUR RESULTS, AND WHAT DO THEY IMPLY FOR FUTURE RESEARCH?" <ul style="list-style-type: none">The presenter makes a compelling case for the novelty and importance of their resultsThe presenter demonstrates that they have a perspective on the direction of future research in their field	20%

Each category will be judged on the scale **Outstanding/Excellent/Very Good/Good/Fair/Poor**. The final poster score will be the average of the content and presentation scores.
